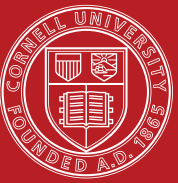

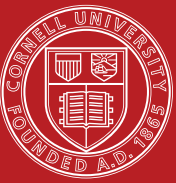

Original Warren Hall built in 1932, \$600,000 price tag

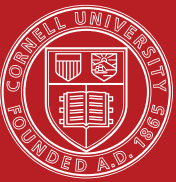
Renovated Warren Hall

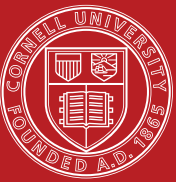
