- **External research funding up 24% in 2013, from \$3.73 million (2012) to \$4.63 million**

Timeline

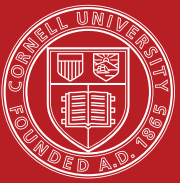
- Original 1932 Warren Hall completed Summer 2013
